

Woodlake United Methodist Church Timeline of Events and Approvals for Hampton Park

June 2000 Church Conference vote to approve purchase of land at Hampton Park

August 2002-Long Range Planning Committee Established

April 2003 Charge Conference-Horizon Team established and Mission Prayer approved as WUMC's mission statement

June 2005 Church Conference-Building Schematics and financial plan for Worship and Discipleship buildings approved

January 2006 Charge Conference-Approval of revised project scope due to increased construction costs

July 2006 Charge Conference-Approval for site work contract with Kjellstrom & Lee and a line of credit from SunTrust

September 2006-Ground Breaking Ceremony at Hampton Park

September 2006 Charge Conference-change in Board of Trustees to coincide with bank documents

November 2006-A Time to Build pledges fall short of total needed to build both Worship and Discipleship buildings due to the dramatic increase in construction costs after Hurricanes Katrina and Rita.

November 2006-A Time to Worship Team formed to assess current worship services and recommend interim solutions for worship due to overcrowding

December 2006-Town Hall and small group meetings held to determine the congregations' choice of either a dedicated Worship building or Discipleship building. Based on feedback received, the Discipleship building will be constructed.

December 2006 Charge Conference-Approval of financial plan to move forward with the Discipleship building at Hampton Park

January 2007-Land clearing and site work begin!

June-July 2007-Building Permit granted and construction begins

April 2007 Charge Conference-Approval for development and construction of playing field and picnic shelter at Hampton Park. Approval also granted to form a nonprofit corporation for the purpose of pursuing community ministries.

July 2007-A Time to Worship recommends, and Church Council approves, moving forward on having worship services at Cosby High School beginning at the same time as the Discipleship building at Hampton Park is open. Town Hall informational meetings and a Church Conference will be held to vote on this recommendation
