Note from the Youth Director:

We are excited to introduce our **SURGE** High School Youth Group this year. **SURGE** stands for **Serve Unite Reach Grow Expand**. The entire year will be focused around the quote “It’s not about me”. We are going to learn how to “clothe ourselves with humility.” (1 Peter 5:5)



Like last year, Youth Group will be structured around the church’s purpose statement:

Loving God, Knowing God, Living Our Faith as Disciples of Christ.

Our monthly **SURGE** Youth Group Schedule will be structured as follows:

- 1st Sunday: Youth Worship**
- 2nd Sunday: Small Groups**
- 3rd Sunday: Mission Project**
- 4th Sunday: Youth Fellowship and Games**

SERVE: To kick off **SURGE** Youth Group, we will dive into missions. Each week we will learn about being a servant and having a servant’s heart.

“Truly I tell you, just as you did it to one of the least of these who are members of my family, you did it to me.” (Matthew 25:4)

UNITE: We will continue to be in mission together while we learn how two are better than one. Each week will develop a sense of unity through group activities, discussions and team building.

“How very good and pleasant it is when kindred live together in unity!” (Psalm 133:1)

REACH: As we learn to serve others we will reach to

God and ask God for guidance. Through this time we will learn about prayer and fasting.

“If any of you is lacking in wisdom, ask God, who gives to all generously and ungrudgingly, and it will be given you.” (James 1:5)

GROW: Once we begin to be in conversation with God we will start to develop a relationship with God. During this time we will grow closer to Him and in our faith.

“Draw near to God, and he will draw near to you.” (James 4:8)

EXPAND: Finally we will discover how to become a contagious community. In the final months of youth group we will take what we have learned out into the world.

“Go into all the world and proclaim the good news to the whole creation.” (Mark 16:15)

Other Youth Group Events:

LOVING GOD

YOUTH SERVICE: Every spring, youth are given an opportunity to lead worship for the entire congregation. They have the opportunity to sing, preach, read scripture, usher, greet, pray, play an instrument, and participate in a skit during the service.

WORSHIP TEAM: Each month high school youth will help lead High School Youth Worship on a rotating basis. We’re looking for youth to sing, play instruments, dance, pray, and read scripture. Rehearsals will be on Mondays with those youth who sign up.



KNOWING GOD

SUNDAY MORNING LIVE: Every Sunday morning youth have an opportunity to come together to study the Bible through discussion and activities.

CONFIRMATION: The purpose of confirmation is to take responsibility for living as a member of the body of Christ and for fulfilling God's purposes. We will meet weekly on Sunday mornings. See the Confirmation brochure for more information.

HIGH SCHOOL CONFERENCE RETREAT: Youth will be challenged to grow as disciples of Christ through powerful worship, Bible study, and small groups all while building new friendships with youth from all over Virginia.

LIVING OUR FAITH

MISSION EVENTS: Starting in October, we will provide monthly mission opportunities which will include Operation Christmas Child, visiting nursing homes and shut-ins, the 30 Hour Famine, river clean up, and other activities where youth can reach out to the community.

GIRLS SMALL GROUP: Each week 6th-12th grade girls will get together for a devotion and hangout time. They will do crafts, watch movies, go on field trips, etc...

HIGH SCHOOL SUPER BOWL PARTY: On Super Bowl Sunday we have a High School Party at the home of one of our youth. Youth will bring refreshments, play games, and watch the “big game” together. This is a great opportunity for youth to get to know one another and have a good time.

MISSION TRIPS: In October we will be announcing our 2012 summer mission trips. Stay tuned for more information.
