WHAT IS THE ANNUAL GIVING CAMPAIGN?

Our leadership teams are planning now for how we will answer God's call for our church in the coming year. One part of that planning is making sure we have the resources to support our ministries. During the Giving Campaign, we share what we plan to do at Woodlake UMC next year and invite you to share an estimate of what you plan to give to help make that plan a reality.

WHAT IS "YES, AND"?

- If they gave \$20/week, the budget would increase by \$156,000.




